The Honor Restoring

Coming out of the Love month of February, Pastor Green taught us how our relationship with our spouse should be a reflection of our relationship with God in his message entitled Marriage 101: Restoring the Honor. Marriage can only be honorable if we follow the blueprint God left us when he created man and woman in the Book of Genesis. Before creating the animals, the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. After God created the animals and brought them to Adam for him to name, there wasn't a help meet for him. And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Many relationships fail because many are unaware of the work it takes to sustain successful marriages when entering into them. Communication and vulnerability with each other as well as a strong relationship with God are some of the ingredients needed to nurture marriages.

When man fails to cleave to his wife, they don't become one flesh and the marriage is breached. Like Adam and Eve hid themselves from God after tasting of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, spouses hide from one another during contentious moments.

As the head of the house, it's important the man communes regularly with God for direction and wisdom in navigating the demands necessary for leadership in the home. As the woman, the woman must know that her role is to support the man in fulfilling the vision God has given him for their relationship. Pastor Green encouraged us to get back to a place where we're naked with our spouse while despising the shame of our past. It's the husband and wife's responsibility to sanctify one another through unconditional love.

What is unconditional love and what does it do? Love suffereth long, and is kind; love envieth not; love vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. Like God shows His Love in the relationship He has with you, the same is required to maintain and restore honor in your marriage with your spouse. Marriage is about your commitment to God through your willingness to honor it through your spouse.
